### **NEW ORGAN**

The organ in our church is the original, installed in 1935, when Msgr. Kunig built the church. While there was one very major overhaul, sometime around 1973, numerous other repairs have been required over time; \$13,000 was spent in the last seven years alone.

We have had to augment the present instrument with digital keyboards tied into those pipes that still operate, and the foot pedals had to be replaced a few years ago. While this has enabled us to continue to provide musical accompaniment for liturgical celebrations, which are the center of the life of every Catholic Parish, parts of the pipe system literally are held together with duct tape and luck; another part blew out just last Sunday.

Several organ specialists and repairmen have been consulted recently. All have advised against making further repairs to a system that has been bandaged to operate far longer than reason should expect and is now on its last legs.

A new organ was included among the projects originally submitted and approved for the *Generations of Faith Campaign*, which will provide the necessary funding, thanks to all who continue to fulfill their pledges.

As a result, we have entered into contract with Allen Organ Company to install a new, enhanced console unit that will be more efficient and virtually maintenance free. We hope to have it installed in time for it to be blessed by Bishop DiMarzio at the end of November. The pipes will remain untouched in their chamber for now, as the new system allows for the possibility of an eventual tie-in.
