#### From the Pastor's Desk:

#### ON THE PRECEPTS OF THE CHURCH

We often complain and bristle about rules and regulations (especially many of those that have come down from the various levels of government of late). Some can be oppressive, but many are given for the proper ordering of society, to avoid chaos, and to advance the "common good".

Canon, or Church, laws are formulated to protect the rights and establish the duties of the members of the Church, laity as well as clergy. Although these number over 2,400, the basic *Precepts of the Church*, applicable to <u>all</u> of the faithful, are reduced today to just five, yes, five. They are directed not toward making life miserable for us, nor are they given as ends in themselves, but rather as tools to provide order to the society of the Church and to guide us toward our goal, our common good as Christians: a proper life here on earth and eternal life in the Kingdom of the Father. They help us to live with one another more fully as members of the Mystical Body of Christ by living holy lives marked by prayer, self-denial, and acts of charity, sustained by the grace of the Sacraments.

There was a time when they were part of our basic religious training. For those who may have forgotten them, or who never learned them, they are as follow:

- 1) To participate at Mass on all Sundays and holy days of obligation.
- 2) To abstain from eating meat and to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, and to abstain from meat on the other Fridays of Lent.
- 3) To confess our sins at least once a year (we always need to be in a state of grace, free from mortal sin, whenever we receive Holy Communion).
- 4) To receive Holy Communion annually at a minimum, specifically between Ash Wednesday and the Solemnity of Pentecost.
- 5) To contribute to the support of the Church with our treasure, our time, and our talents.

What could be simpler to carry out? And yet so many abandon the simple practice of the Faith (the "spiritual but not religious" set), or we hesitate to do so, or we do so not out of love for God but under fear and compulsion. How different, how much more beautiful and richer our lives would be, if we just allowed the grace that God offers us this Lent to transform our lives, so that we might grow in our love for Him and one another and thus build up the Body of Christ!

The days before Easter are passing swiftly. Live the Faith today, so as to celebrate the great Feast of Feasts with hearts and minds made new!
