From the Pastor's desk:

A new NYS law concerning lawsuits brought against individuals and/or institutions, secular as well as religious, for alleged sexual abuse will go into effect this Thursday, August 15. Among its provisions, it allows for a 1-year window period for new claims, regardless of how long ago the abuse may have occurred or the current age of the plaintiff, suspending the statute of limitations.

The Church as been a major defendant in the past and is likely to be so under this law. Programs and Procedures have been established to address the problem properly and to reduce as fas as possible the likelihood of future abuse by clergy and other Church personnel. The following reporting hotline has been posted in the Mass Bells and in each of our buildings: NY State hotline, 1-800-342-3720.

Thursday is also the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a holy day of obligation. In addition to attending Mass, please pray the Rosary to ask our Lady to intercede for the healing of the abused and the repentance of the perpetrators, and for the Church, that the failings of some of our brothers and sisters may not discourage or impede the rest of us from living the beauty of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Directly or indirectly, all of us have been affected. St. Paul reminded us that, when one member of the Body of Christ suffers, all suffer. All of us are called now to heal the pain. Let us respond as best we can by the grace of God with our prayers, our presence, and our actions.


